SWIMMING POOL

During swim team season, the pool is open from 11:00am until 9:00pm, Monday through Friday; and from 10:00am until 9:00pm, Saturday and Sunday. Following swim team season, it will be open from 10:00am until 9:00pm, Monday through Sunday.

The pool is available for lap swimming to residents over fourteen (14) years old from 5:00am until 6:30am.

Access is done by use of electronic key card. If a member's HOA annual dues are not current or the facility is closed due to repairs/upkeep access will be denied. The pool gate must be closed and locked after entering or leaving the pool area.

All children (0-13 years old) must be accompanied and supervised by a parent, guardian or an adult. NO guests – Residents Only.

Staff member, management company or Board of Directors shall at all times have the right to ask residents to leave the pool if, in his/her opinion, it becomes unsafe for swimming.

The Wilshire Farms Swimming Pool <u>may not</u> be reserved for private parties, except for use by the Board of Directors for use during a community sponsored event. Organized activities (leagues, ladder, tournaments, lessons, or team practices) must have prior HOA Board approval.

NO lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk.

NO running.

NO diving.

NO unnecessary roughness.

NO abusive or foul language.

Floats, rafts, etc. are not permitted.

One person at a time is allowed on the slide. Slide feet first only, in a sitting position. Never stop or stand on the slide. Once entering the water, move out of the way as quickly as possible.

NO food or gum is allowed in the water.

NO glass bottles or containers are allowed inside the fenced pool area.

NO alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area.

The Wilshire Farms Swimming Pool and Clubhouse is a no smoking facility.

Pets will not be permitted inside the fenced pool area.

Proper swim attire is required.

All infants must wear appropriate swimsuits and swim diapers. No disposable diapers will be allowed. Unsanitary habits will not be tolerated.

No entry if you have a fever or are sick.

No entry if you are subject to a quarantine order or recommendation.

No entry if you have cuts or open wounds.

No electrical devices (only battery operated) are allowed inside the fenced pool area. The volume of musical devices must be kept low enough so as not to disturb other pool users.

No one will be allowed in the water during an electrical storm. The pool will be closed during electrical storms.

HOA property and equipment must be treated with respect.

Pick up after yourself. All cans, paper, and other debris must be deposited in trash and recycling bins provided when leaving the pool area.
