CELEBRATE INDEPENDENCE DAY WITH LEGAL FIREWORKS IN SHAWNEE

In May, the City Council voted to allow fireworks under the following guidelines:

- Fireworks may be set off between 10 a.m. and 11 p.m. on July 3 and July 4, 2022.
- Sparklers, smoke bombs, fountains and other fireworks are allowed.
- Bottle rockets, sky lanterns and M80's are NOT allowed.
- You may NOT light off fireworks in the following locations:
 - Within 150 feet from fireworks stands and gas pumps
 - Within 1,000 feet from medical buildings, elder care facilities, public buildings and schools
 - Under, on or from a vehicle
 - Into a gathering of people
 - Public property including parks, sidewalks and streets
 - Cemeteries
 - Inside any building or structure
