Tennis Court Rules and Regulations

- The White Horse tennis courts are for the exclusive use of White Horse residents in good standing with the association.
- Tennis courts are not to be used after 10:00 PM.
- The entry gate may not be propped open for any period of time and must remain securely closed.
- Residents may gain access to the courts through the locked gate which may be opened with the use of an active key fob/card.
- Guests are permitted to utilize the tennis courts with a Whitehorse resident. Resident must provide access. Guests must be accompanied by a resident at all time.
- Reservations are not required. Players will use the "first come first serve" basis of play. Players may use the courts for only one hour at a time unless no one is waiting to play.
- Courts are for tennis only and may not be used for any other purpose. Roller skates, skateboards, scooters, bicycles, etc. are strictly prohibited.
- No ball playing of any kind other than tennis is permitted.
- Tennis players must wear sneakers or tennis shoes with rubber soles.
- Proper tennis attire is required.
- No glass containers allowed within the fenced tennis court area.
- No dogs or pets allowed on tennis courts.
- No smoking is permitted within the fenced area.
- Residents are responsible for their guests at all times.
- Immediately following the use of the courts, residents and guests must clean up the area, throw away trash and remove all personal belongings.
- Players are required to observe tennis courtesies, as well as rules of good conduct on and around the courts.
